The items needed for ages 4- 9 are: Socks, Underwear, Body wash, Children's shampoo & conditioner, Comb, Lotion, Shirts, stretchy Pants, Pajamas, Toothbrush/toothpaste, Age appropriate book, Small blanket or quilt, Plush animal, Writing journal with pen or pencil, girl Hair brush, girl Barrettes/hair ties. All items need to be new; Travel size toiletries will work. We plan to fill several backpacks and donate the remaining items. You may donate as many items off the list as you want.
